More Work with Prepositions Sometimes you might mistake another kind of phrase for a prepositional phrase For example, do not confuse a prepositional phrase with a subordinate clause Example: Before we go, take your coat from the closet Even though before can be used as a preposition, before we go is a subordinate clause

Prepositional Phrases As Adverbs A prepositional phrase is a group of words beginning with a preposition and ending with a noun or pronoun The noun or pronoun at the end of the phrase is called the object of the preposition Often there are other descriptive words between the preposition and its object

Prepositional phrase attachment ambiguity resolution using ...

PP-attachment ambiguity arises when a sentence contains a prepositional phrase (PP), after a verb complemented by a noun, making it syntactically ambiguous to determine what the PP attaches to, the verb or the noun and often tend to semantic errors in NLP (Dekang Lin, 1998)
