Solution of the conflict under the target to do so constructively whilst aiming for maximum satisfaction of the wishes of all involved parties Incongruity may arise in the case of a conflict not being resolved in a sustainable way A quick and satisfying resolution is likely to be hindered if one attempts to re-solve a conflict without prior
